Dicor, which has operated for 32 years, supplies a wide variety of products to the industry through its affiliate brands, which include Dicor Products, United Shade, Vixen Composites and Seal Design.

"The Dicor team is looking forward to joining the Airxcel family," Dicor President Gregg Fore said in a news release distributed by Airxcel late Friday. "We have long been an admirer of Airxcel's leading product initiatives and their culture of excellence. Being associated with Airxcel will allow each entity to benefit from the other's key competencies and drive higher levels of customer satisfaction."

Specifically, Dicor brands make RV roofing systems, wheel componentry, window shades, FRP, composite paneling, window sealing as well as a wide array of aftermarket care and repair products.
